



Road Rally School



Kansas Region SCCA TSD Road Rally

Sunday, March 4, 2007

This road rally school is designed to introduce contestants to the concepts involved in SCCA Time-Speed-Distance road rallies. The school will consist of a one hour lecture followed by a short rally. Contestants will return to the starting location for a question and answer session followed by a second short rally. Following the event, an optional social event will be held at a local establishment. Instructors and Rallymasters for this event are Rich Bireta and Albert Weaver.

The rally leg will traverse paved rural roads only. The rally is a test of precision driving and teamwork between driver and navigator. Straightforward, non-devious route instructions with specified average speeds will test the rallyists' ability to arrive at unknown checkpoint locations on time, neither early nor late.

Any street-legal automobile capable of normal rural highway speeds can be entered. Contestants should bring a road worthy car, driver, navigator, accurate watch, pencil/pen and clipboard.

When: Sunday, March 4, 2007. Registration 1:00 pm with class starting at 2:00 pm. First car finishes around 5pm.

Entry Fee: \$5.00
