etc.) to get settled and then to the nearest pub for some refreshments. It's a tough job, but somebody has to do it **J**.

Saturday morning, the work began. Like most SCCA conventions, there are different venues going on simultaneously, so you have to make a decision on exactly what you want to go to. "Hmmm. . . F&C, Race Control or Oil & Lubricants?" It's hard to put what went on over 8 intensive hours, but here's some highlights that may interest you. If you want some more detailed information about anything, please contact me.

Solo Town Hall meeting. This was a short one - lasting only about 15 minutes. It appears that the Solo program in the Division is running so smoothly that the only thing to discuss was the schedule for Divisional Solo II's. A bit of bad news was also announced. Sam Scharnberg is retiring as our Solo Steward. We'll miss her greatly!

Regional Finances. The IRS audited two of our Regions and outcomes were both good and bad. They put out a lot of information that we can use to avoid some problems.

Questions and Answers with Steve Johnson. A big point of discussion was that Heartland Park is up for sale. No, SCCA will not be buying it ;-).

The Executive Committee Meeting and Scheduling. This meeting was absolutely full of information and discussion in a very short time (2 hours). Topics ranged from program reports (from Solo to Sound Control and everything in between) to the actual scheduling of next year's schedule. To keep this short, here's a *very* short synopsis of what went on in different areas. Again, please contact me if you'd like more information about any particular topic.

Possible change of current race groupings - no change as of now.

Creation of an IT7 class for RX7's with the 12A motor - not now.

Changes in Club Formula Continental class - no change.

Transponders. Due to the cost to the competitor, cost to the Regions (or Race Groups), the necessity of having even more people in T&S, no transponders systems in the Division for now.

Scheduling. As of this moment, AVRГ is on the books for three R/N races (if we get approval) and a S/R. The third National race in August is very questionable. Even if we are granted a waiver from National to hold a third R/N at Hallett, it is still contingent on the MVRG getting contracts from MAM to hold any races. If they do get contracts to have their two R/N races there, our third race will be gone. Please check the websites (MiDiv or Wichita Region) for the full schedule.

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all the Solo Safety Stewards for the work they do. I received a phone call asking if I would go up to Salina and work as the Safety Steward for the KSU "driver's school." Somewhere in the conversation it was mentioned that all the SSS's do is stand around. Not!!! It's a very stressful job; having to make decisions about course designs, trying to keep your head swiveling *all* the time looking for potential problems on course, in grid, in the paddock, in the area surrounding the site; hearing every tire screech and wondering if someone is getting into a major problem; making sure that all safety rules are being followed (waiver signing, tech, speed limits, etc.), and a whole list of other things. Being a Solo Safety Steward is a very tough job and your work is very much appreciated!

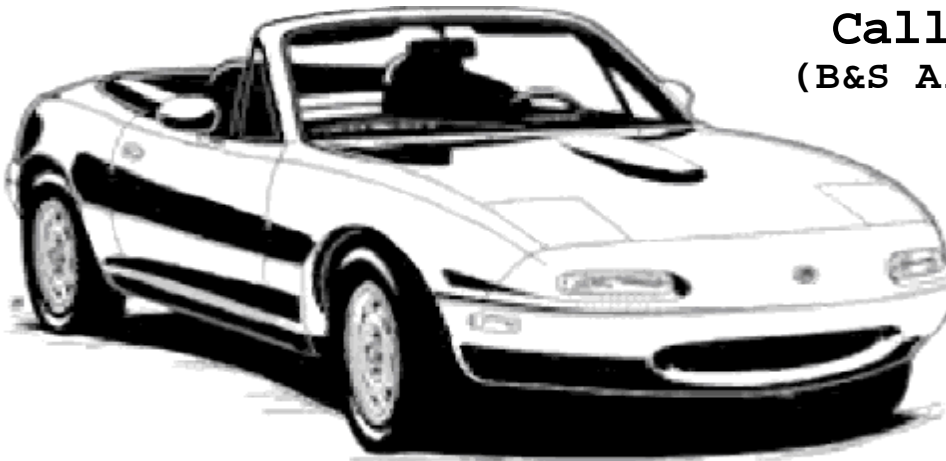

MID-AM REPORT

Once the dust had settled on the Mid-Am Bonus Race at Gateway, half a dozen drivers had come from behind to claim Mid-Am Championships. They are among 20 drivers to become the 2002 champions. Every MiDiv Region but one has at least one award-winning (top-3) driver this year, but Kansas City Region is the big dog with nine of the 20 champions.

KANSAS CITY REGION tops its list with three drivers who posted perfect 84-point scores – six wins including one at the Bonus Race. But a driver who just missed perfection – an 81-point score, probably deserves the most notable mention. That would be **David Long**, who made the biggest jump of any champion, as he was fourth in E Production points, but leaped to a winning 81-point total with his Bonus Race victory. It was Long's second championship -- the first coming 24 years ago when he won A Sedan. No, not American Sedan, but A Sedan -- the class which later became GT1. As for the rest – **Ron Lentz** won SRF for the fourth year in a row and **Michael Starnes** won his seventh Mid-Am championship and his second in GT1, both coming to the Bonus Race in second place. **Bob Gill** had it a little easier in ITA as he was the class leader going in and came out fifth in the Driver of the Year rankings. **Charles Guenther** tallied 81 points to take GT3 for the second year in a row. **Tim Koch** won eight times to take Formula Ford. **Al Essig** had a six-win season for his third S2000 crown. Late-starting **Harlan Moore** won four of the last five races to take his second straight Super Prod title. **Jarold Boettcher** and **Mark Buffon** went 1-2 in ITC. **Mike McGinley** pulled up a runner-up finish in ITE. **O.L. Kinney Jr.** went DNF at the Bonus, but held on for third in SRF.

OZARK MOUNTAIN REGION has three champions, among them the No. 2 and 3 drivers in the Driver of the Year rankings. **Loren Moore** made a strong run at that award, winning all 16 races he ran in Touring 1. Right behind him on the DotY list was **Chuck Leighton**, 11 times a winner for the G Production crown. **Shane Bennoch** won his third F/Continental championship. Three other awards go to **Dick Faxon**, runner-up in Spec Miata; **Sam Henry**, second in American Sedan, and **Forrest Tindall**, third in EP.

NEBRASKA REGION also boasts three champions, led by **Ted Johnson**, who broke out of a 72-point American Sedan tie with Sam Henry by winning the Bonus Race and his third straight championship. **Jeff Demetri**, with seven wins, took ITE for a second year. **Jan Gerber** won SSC with the ex-John Saucier Neon. **Hans Iwand** won second in Club Ford and **John Waldbaum** finished third in ITE.

ST. LOUIS REGION's **Timothy Finley** was third in ITA until he won the Bonus Race and leaped to the championship. **Tom Coppage** won his second Club Ford championship 14 years after he won his first in 1988. Runner-up awards will go to **Mary Daly** in GT1, Gary Payne in FF, **Robert Briggen** in ITB, and **Bob Eichelberger** in FP. **Jay Musgrave** won the Bonus to take third in Formula Continental.

NEOKLA REGION has three award winners topped by **Mickey Schreiner**, who added his first F Production title to seven prior ones in HP. **Marty Wagner** was second in ITS, and **Frank Chambers** third in CF.

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS REGION's RE **Chris Albin** won ITB with a 16-win season, which also gave him his seventh Driver of the Year award.

MID-SOUTH REGION's only award is **Don Wiseman**'s second Spec Miata championship added to three earlier ones won in SSC.

Others receiving awards were:

KANSAS – **Ronald Davis**, 2nd in EP, and **Bill Allman**, 2nd in SRF.

DES MOINES VALLEY – **Greg Scharnberg**, 2nd in FC; **David Volante**, 3rd in ITA, and **Tom Kraft**, 3rd in SM.

ARKANSAS – **Norm Floyd**, 2nd in ITA, and **Dan Crossett**, 3rd in ITS.

SALINA – **Rocky Entriken**, 2nd in GP.

WICHITA – **Ray Barker**, 3rd in ITC, and **Scott Bettinger**, 3rd in American Sedan.

OKLAHOMA – **Russell Neely**, 3rd in ITB.

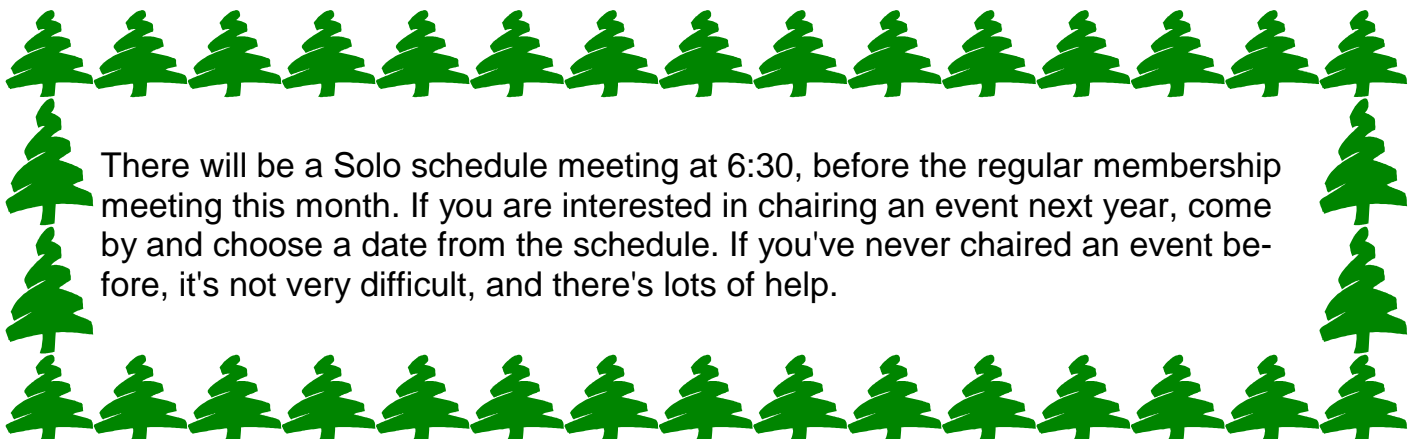
